Much more than the sum of its parts, this has bramble, blackcurrant and tangerine notes, subtle mocha oak, caressing tannins and wonderful length.



CA2 / CARMENERE COSTA

CA2 comes from Lolol in coastal Colchagua and exhibits the perfume and texture that are typical of the best Carmeneres from the sub-region. Intense, silky and very finely balanced, this is a wine whose flavours and elegance owe as much to Cabernet Franc in style. Ripe, plush and complex, with graphite and black cherry notes.
