If you are looking for a textbook Carmenère from Maule, this great-value wine from TerraNoble is a strong contender. Exuding the sweet paprika spice so typical of the variety and region, this is a well-balanced and appetising wine with ripe blackberry notes, cacao and a smooth finish. A bonafide classic.
