

HARVEST 2026: A YEAR OF HISTORICAL MILESTONES AND EXCEPTIONAL QUALITY

With 80% progress and yields 10% higher than projected, we are concluding a harvest of impeccable health.



The 2026 harvest at TerraNoble will go down as one of the most dynamic and early-ripening in our history. With an **early start on February 17** and the close of fruit reception on **April 2**, we completed an exceptionally short and concentrated campaign. To date, we have successfully finished deliveries to our San Clemente winery, reaching **80%** overall progress and a total of 1,715 tons received.

This season was ahead of schedule by at least 15 days, requiring simultaneous harvesting across various valleys and varieties. An unprecedented milestone was our **Casablanca estate**, which was harvested entirely during the month of March, something for which we have no prior records. In terms of production, yields have been **10% higher than projected**, driven by larger, heavier clusters than in previous seasons.

The fruit shows impeccable health and outstanding acid balance, factors that foreshadow excellent wines with the cool-climate freshness we value so highly. Although we expect to formally close the agricultural campaign during the first fortnight of April, the grapes are already safely tucked away, promising a vintage of great character and structure.

What's next?

Our team is fully focused on moving forward with fermentations and beginning the aging process. For now, we continue to evaluate the quality in the cellar, which looks extremely interesting and faithful to our identity.
