

JAMES SUCKLING'S CHILE 2020 REPORT IMPORTANT RECOGNITIONS FOR OUR WINES



GRAN RESERVA CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2017 / 92 PTS.

A cabernet sauvignon with bright, currant and berry character with some fresh-herb undertones. Full-bodied with soft tannins that are tight and polished. Juicy and flavorful at the finish. Drink or hold.



LAHUEN 2017 / 92 PTS.

Aromas of red plums and mulberries, as well as gently leafy notes. There's a very supple feel to this mid-weight red with mellow tannins carrying a long, smooth, blueberry and blackberry palate. Flavorful finish. Drink or hold.



CA1 ANDES 2017 / 91 PTS.

The wood is assertively played here and sits atop the ripe blueberries and lightly peppery red fruit. Leafy aromas, too. The palate has succulently delivered tannins and a punchy tannin kick, holding fresh red-plum and berry flavors. Drink or hold.



CA2 COSTA 2017 / 90 PTS.

Distinctive notes of cool herbs here with a gently smoky and leafy edge. The palate follows suit with bright, blue-fruit flavors and a streak of savory, smoked-meat flavors. Drink now.



DISIDENTE SYRAH · TEMPRANILLO 2017 / 90 PTS.

Very spicy, fragrant purple fruit and flowers here with some savory mahogany and toasty oak. The palate is vivid and fresh and there's a gently smoky streak through the ripe plums and berries. A blend of 90% syrah and 10% tempranillo. Drink or hold.
